BY-LAW 981-2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Durie Street.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

- 1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
- A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Durie Street	East	A point 61 metres south of St. John's Road and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime from Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive, and from the 1st day to the 15th day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive
Durie Street	West	A point 61 metres south of St. John's Road and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime from the 16th day to the last day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30 inclusive
