ARTICLE I

Township of Etobicoke¹

[Adopted 1963-01-08 as By-Law No. 13,720]

§ 233-1. Movies, concerts, performances and lectures lawful.

It is hereby declared that Section 2, Subsection (1), of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act, 1960-61, applies in the Township of Etobicoke after 1:30 p.m. of the Lord's Day and that the said Subsection (1) shall apply to the exhibition of moving pictures, theatrical performances, concerts and lectures.

ARTICLE II

Town of Mimico²

[Adopted 1959-01-09 as By-Law No. 1864]

§ 233-2. Declaration of legality; hours. [Amended 1962-05-31 by By-Law No. 1934]

It is hereby declared that Section 1 of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act, R.S.O. 1950, c. 218, is, from the date of the passing of this Article, in force in the Town of Mimico and that, pursuant to the said provisions, it is lawful for any person between 1:30 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. of the Lord's Day to provide, engage in or be present at any public game or sport that is specified in this Article or to do or engage any other person to do any work, business or labour in connection with any such public game or sport which, but for the said Act, would be unlawful under Section 4 of the Lord's Day Act (Canada) 1950.

§ 233-3. Lawful activities.

The application of said Section 1 of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act shall be limited to the following public games or sports:

- A. The operation of indoor bowling-alleys for five-pin and ten-pin bowling in bowling-alleys licenced by the Licencing Commission for the Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto.
- B. Roller-skating. [Added 1962-05-31 by By-Law No. 1934]
- C. Billiards or pool in a premises duly licenced by the Licencing Commission for the Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto. [Added 1962-10-22 by By-Law No. 1949]
- D. Lacrosse. [Added 1966-06-20 by By-Law No. 2019]

ARTICLE III

Town of New Toronto: Sports³

[Adopted 1962-11-26 as By-Law No. 2314]

§ 233-4. Lawful games or sports.

It is hereby declared that Section 1, Subsection (1), of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act, 1960-61, applies in the Town of New Toronto between the hours of 1:30 p.m. of the Lord's Day and 11:00 p.m. of the Lord's Day with respect to the following specific public games or sports: bowling and billiards.

ARTICLE IV

Town of New Toronto: Movies and Concerts⁴
