Realignment of Permit Parking Area 7E to exclude the development address of 875-887 Queen Street East

SUMMARY

Transportation Services is requesting approval from City Council to amend the boundary of permit parking area 7E.

Transportation Services has assessed the realignment of permit parking area 7E to exclude the property located at 875-887 Queen Street East as requested by Toronto and East York Community Council on June 13, 2017. Transportation Services is recommending approval of the realignment as it will not impact negatively on the permit parking area.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Manager, Transportation Services, Right of Way Management, Toronto and East York District recommends that City Council:

1. Approve the amendment to Schedule B of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate a revised map of permit parking area "7E", as attached in Appendix A of the report dated September 6, 2017 from the Manager, Right of Way Management, Transportation Services, Toronto and East York District.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact associated with this report.

DECISION HISTORY

At its meeting June 13, 2017 Toronto and East York Community Council in considering item TE25.128, requested Transportation Services to examine and report back to Toronto and East York Community Council regarding the realignment of permit parking area 7E and the exclusion of the subject site at 875-887 Queen Street East.

COMMENTS

Permit Parking area 7E is bounded on the west by East Don Roadway, on the north by Queen Street East, on the east by Logan Avenue and the south by the Gardiner Expressway. Area 7E has 327 on-street parking spaces. To date, 250 permits have been issued. This area does not have a history of being waitlisted, meaning the demand for overnight on-street parking permits has never exceeded the supply of parking spaces. There is TTC service on Queen Street East. Councillor Fletcher and residents neighbouring 875-887 Queen Street East support this action as a means of ensuring that this new development does not negatively impact the permit parking supply to the existing neighbourhood.

A Public Notice was placed on the City's website requesting those objecting to the exclusion of 875 – 887 Queen Street East, from permit parking area "7E" to forward their objections in writing to the City Clerk, so they may be scheduled as deputations at the Toronto and East York Community Council meeting. The Clerk has confirmed that no objections have been received.

Transportation Services has no objections to the exclusion of 875-887 Queen Street East from permit parking area 7E.
